When I came to America, my unique turbaned look helped me get a place to stay and I was able to further help other professionals coming from India find accommodation and jobs. Another major task I undertook was helping buy the Richmond Hill Gurdwara which provided a central hub for people to connect and help each other. Due to my turban, I was able to secure a nice job within a month at a time when the economy was very bad. Arriving in this country with just \$70 I went on to build 300,000 sq ft of commercial real estate property for myself. I was able to bring into effect a Tax Abatement law which caused a real estate boom to all 5 boroughs of NYC and has benefited countless developers and provided millions upon millions of dollars to NYC.

With Donald Trump as my mentor I built Bagga Tower in 1995 which was built from the inside up without a crane or scaffolding, A one of a kind construction in NY. and later on I developed Bagga Plaza I in Syosset, Bagga Plaza II in Hicksville and Bagga Plaza III in Bayside. After this fairy tale success as Real Estate Investor & Builder, I was honored as the Donald J. Trump of the Indian Community.
